This afternoon all of the children got to spend an hour getting to know their new teacher and familiarising themselves with their new classroom. We hope the children are looking forward to starting a new term in September!

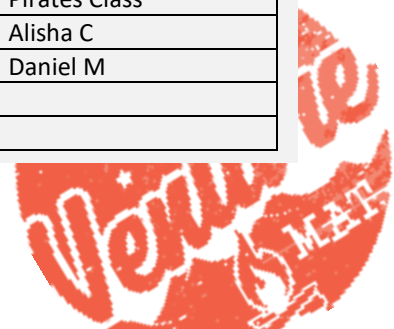

This week saw Pirates finish their Global Boarders surf session – these sessions have been a fantastic addition to our curriculum for Year 5 and the progress we’ve seen amongst all of the children has been amazing! Well done to you all, hopefully you’ll get to put some of what you have learnt into practice at the beach this summer! We start surfing again straight away in September with our new Pirates & Buccaneers classes! ☺

On Monday we will conclude our sporting year with our sports awards – we have lots of videos to share with the children as we look at all of the after school clubs and competitions we’ve participated in this year! To highlight how busy we (children and staff) have been:

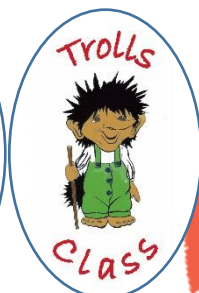
