## SPORT ENRICHMENT TRIPS & VISITS 2021/22

This year we've been able to restart our enrichment sports trips! These trips look to inspire our children and give them the opportunity to experience first class sporting facilities and sports performance! In December 2021 we returned to Sandy park to take part in an Exeter Chiefs Super Saturday experience! We had great fun during the training session, working on our skills and tackling! We got to watch the team defeat Saracens 18-15 in a closely fought encounter, showcasing some of the games best players! We walked the pitch at half time and got to meet a few players post match!



In March 2022 we visited Wolverhampton Wanderers for the first time! We had a really fun but challenging training session at the Sir Jack Hayward training facility – the children worked on their abilities to beat their opponents 1 v 1! That evening we watched Wolves play Leeds Utd at Molineux! It was a Friday night game, under floodlights, which meant we were treated to a really exciting pre match fire canon display! Leeds came from 2-0 down to win 3-2 in the last minutes of the game! The atmosphere was great and we saw it all, goals, a red card & injuries, which resulted in a huge amount of injury time being played!



We stayed at Lillieshall, a national sports centre which was very exciting, the food was great. The following morning we returned to Molineux to take part in a behind the scenes stadium tour, we sat in the dugouts and changing rooms, viewed the pitch from the directors boxes and even walked out from the tunnel to the side of the pitch! We also visited the museum and the club shop where we were able to buy some souvenirs!



Unfortunately, we were unsuccessful in this years Wimbledon Tennis ballot but we were able to secure some tickets to a first division County Cricket match between Somerset & Yorkshire which we plan to attend towards the end of July! ## SEND Sporting opportunities

We reintroduced our Trevictus Games event with a winter games held at CSIA in December 2021, 64 children took part in a range of activities, including archery, boccia, parachute games, foam javelin throw & standing long jumps! We had several local primary schools join us for the morning. We also took part in the Table Cricket initiative run by Cornwall Cricket, with David Painter coming into school to help deliver sessions for mainstream & ARB children. This culminated in us attending a county competition at Bodmin College!
